NOTICE OF *ENTRY OF APPEARANCE BY GLEN R. GRAHAM and*
REQUEST FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT REPORTS PER
22 OS §258 AND EXCULPATORY EVIDENCE

Comes now the Defendant, above, by and through his attorney of record, Glen R. Graham, who enters his appearance and does hereby request that the District Attorney release a copy of any and all law enforcement reports pursuant to title 22 O.S. § 258 and *LaFortune v. District Court of Tulsa County*, 1998 OK CR 64, 972 P.2d 864. [Regarding mandatory disclosure of all law enforcement reports possessed by, or within the knowledge of the prosecution] and due process of law under the 14th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution and Art. 2, § 7 of the Oklahoma Constitution, and *United States v. Agurs*, 427 U.S. 97, 112 (1976), wherein the U.S. Supreme Court held that certain **exculpatory evidence** must be disclosed *even when it is not requested* by the defense and there is an ethical obligation to disclose exculpatory evidence. Defendant specifically requests that the State additionally disclose any **exculpatory evidence** in this matter.
