

SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT
CONCERNING ATTORNEY SERVICES

Now on this _____ day of _____, 20____, the below parties enter into this is the supplemental agreement concerning attorney services between _____, hereinafter "Attorney" and _____, hereinafter "Client," or both referred to as "parties."

The parties hereto agree that attorney should be paid *additional fees* prior to setting a case for any jury trial or handling any jury trial or handling any kind of appeal. Attorney will accept payments but is entitled to be paid prior to setting for trial or appeal. *Any kind of work what-so-ever* after sentencing is billed at the rate stated below.

The parties hereto agree that in the event the client enters into one of the alternative courts such as "drug court," "dui court," "mental health court," veteran's court," "accelerated accountability court," "community sentencing court," or one of the other alternative courts then this attorney is entitled to be paid for each court appearance *that requires* this attorney to appear. That the minimum fee for any court appearance is \$200, or \$200 per hour whichever is greater which is due with each appearance. That in the event that the client fails to pay, attorney may request a continuance, may seek to withdraw, may ask other counsel to appear with billing, and/or may seek to add it to an *on-going account or suit* for attorney fees.

That the Client retains the option of hiring other counsel and thereby any additional bill up to the time that new counsel enters an appearance would cease. That Client may ask the court to allow this attorney to withdraw but in the event that this attorney is not allowed to withdraw and is required to do any additional work such as court appearances, then the client shall be liable for the same at the rate stated above.

In the event that client or the court requires this attorney to appear for any applications to accelerate/revoke probation or motion for sanctions or any types additional court appearances then the client agrees to pay the attorney at the rate stated above or be liable for the same and to pay in a reasonable time upon demand. Attorney fee for any felony jury trial is a minimum of \$7,500.00 or more, and the minimum for a misdemeanor jury trial is \$2,500.00 or more. Client is NOT liable for same if new counsel enters before trial, or attorney is allowed to withdraw before trial.
